## 2+2 INTERNATIONAL TRANSFER PROGRAM

In cooperation with an international partner university, this program allows students to study in the United States for part of their degree program.

Students may transfer up to 2 years (60 credit hours) from a university in their home country. The student may then complete the remaining 2 years (60 credit hours) at Missouri S&T.

The program allows two advantages:

1. Students will have the opportunity to study in the United States for part of their academic career.
2. Student will receive a degree from Missouri S&T and a degree from their home country/university.



## 2+2+1 INTERNATIONAL TRANSFER PROGRAM

The first four years are similar to the 2+2 program. This option, however, allows a student to earn an MBA or MS-IST with one additional year at Missouri S&T.

Students may transfer up to 2 years (60 credit hours) from a university in their home country. The student may then complete the remaining 2 years (60 credit hours) at Missouri S&T.

During their senior year, students may dual enroll and take some graduate courses while still undergraduate students. This allows the remaining graduate coursework to be completed within one additional year.

The program allows four advantages:

1. Students will have the opportunity to study in the United States for part of their academic career.
2. Students will receive a degree from Missouri S&T, and a degree from their home country/university.
3. Students will receive a graduate degree from Missouri S&T.
4. For students with excellent GPAs, the GRE/GMAT exam will be waived when applying to the graduate degree program.
